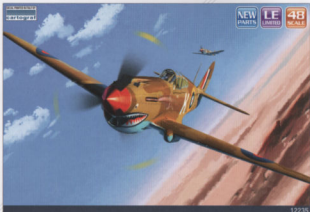

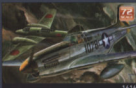

The Typhoon was well-suited for low-level attacks on shipping and armored divisions thanks to its twin-mounted 20mm cannons and capability of carrying eight ABB rockets.



**TEMPEST V**

An elaboration of the Typhoon, the Tempest featured elliptical wings, allowing for higher airspeed and lower compressibility.



**SPITFIRE MK.XIVc**

The Mk.XIVc model of the British workhorse Spitfire plane featured a strengthened airframe designed to hold the weight of a larger engine and five-blade propeller.



**MESSERSCHMITT BF109G-6**

The Bf109, which first saw action in 1937 during the Spanish Civil War and went on to become one of the Luftwaffe's most important aircraft.



**JU-87G STUKA "TANK BUSTER"**

This cranked-wing dive-bomber, initially flown in 1936, and ground attack aircraft lasted through World War II.
