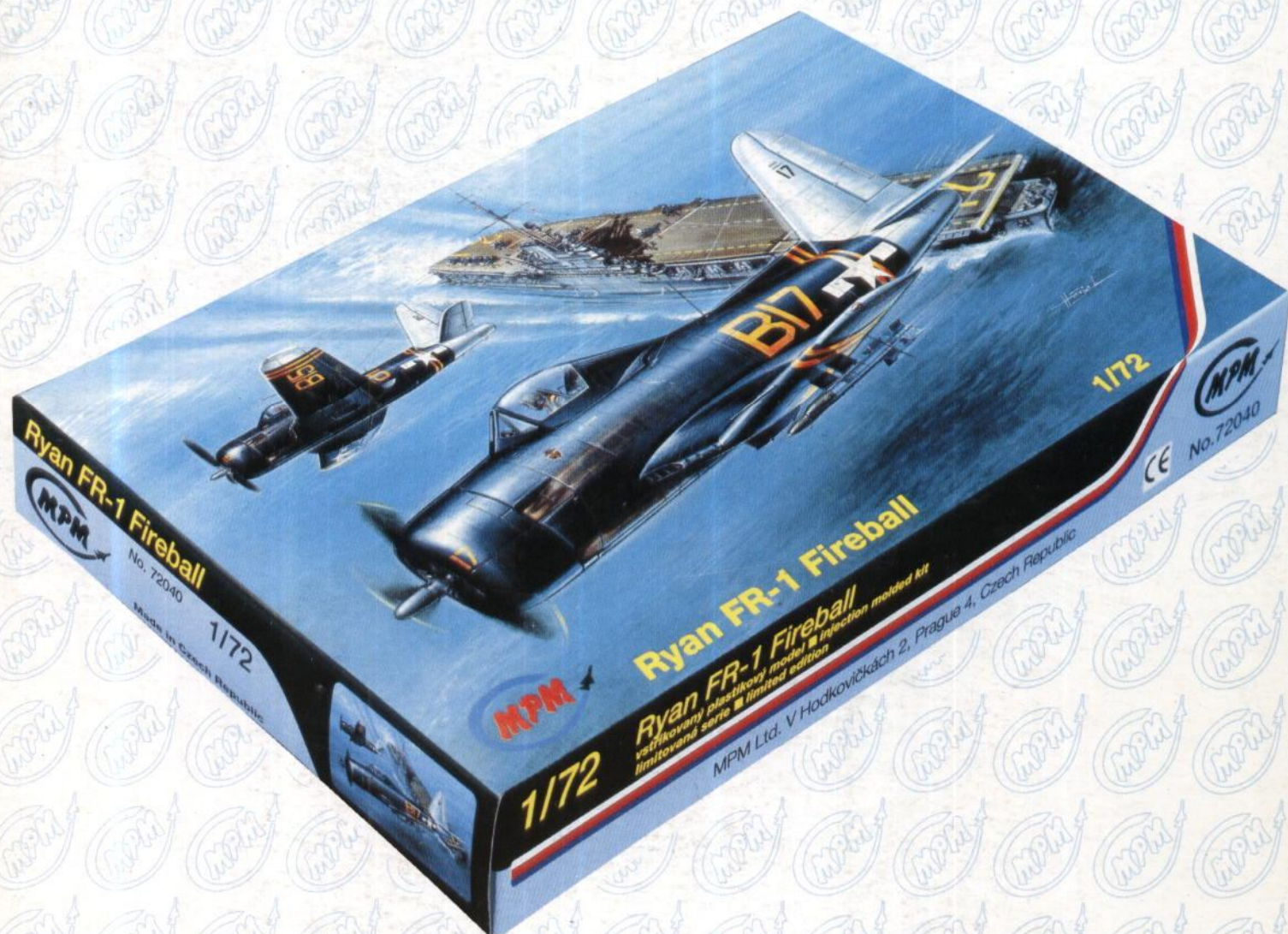

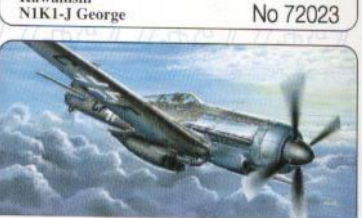

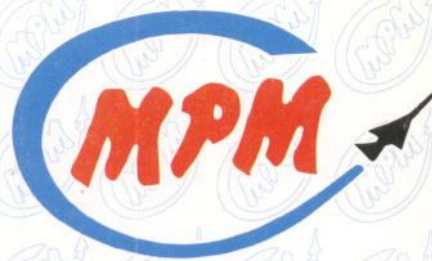

CAC Wirraway

No. 72064

The Wirraway was a great aircraft. Few aircraft have been remembered with such affection among Australian wartime pilots as the „Old Wirraway.“ Undoubtedly the most versatile A/C of the entire RAAF, it was utilized in a number of roles ranging from trainer to interceptor fighter to dive bomber and low level artillery spotter.



Sikorski R-4 No. 72045

The R-4 series were the first production helicopters outside Germany, and among the first in the world. By 1944 a batch of 100 R-4Bs were being built. They were used mainly for pilot training and trials purposes.

Messerschmitt Bf 109T No. 72066

Perhaps the most interesting conversion of the Bf 109E was the Bf 109T series of carrier-borne fighters intended to operate from the aircraft carrier Graf Zeppelin.



Mitsubishi J8M1 Shusui No. 72037

Japan was able to acquire the manufacturing rights for the Me-163 rocket-powered interceptor fighter. Mitsubishi was assigned to produce the Japanese version of this rocket-powered fighter under the designation J8M1 Shusui. The first prototype completed in June 1945.
